Violation of this rule may result in your dismissal from Yearbook U.</b> Advisers or representatives who must transport students during the Workshop must sign students out in the Yearbook U Office prior to leaving campus. Parents may arrange to have their son/daughter leave campus (church, summer school, previous obligation, etc.), but written permission to do so must be presented to Yearbook U Directors prior to leaving.</p> <p><b>Any destruction of school or Yearbook U property is prohibited. All attendants are expected to attend all classes and planned activities, unless absence has been cleared with Yearbook U Directors.</b> We use an Honor System where roll is taken on a random basis. Students who are not present for attendance or who are found away from their assigned location will have parents and/or advisers contacted for the first offense, and may be subject to dismissal.</p> <p><b>Disrespectful conduct will not be tolerated. Use or possession of alcohol, cigarettes, or illegal drugs is prohibited.
